Alongside this project we have given our House Teams a mission to get collecting and fill the dustbins in the hall with the materials and objects the classes have added to the shopping list below. We can then put unused and unwanted things to very good use. Please could you help your child to find as many items as possible, they will put them in their team's dustbin – the first team to fill their bin to the top wins 50 points!

Natural Materials

- bags of pebbles, stones, shingle
- leaves, ferns, moss
- sticks
- wooden battens
- feathers
- bark, bark chippings
- acorns, conkers, fir cones
- fallen fruit e.g. apples
- straw
- shells
- dandelions, yellow leaves

Recycled Materials

- blue towels
- cardboard, cardboard toilet tubes
- nails, screws
- red, orange, yellow cellophane sweet wrappers
- blue and black rubble/rubbish/compost and plastic bags
- waterproof fabric
- green plastic water/soft drink bottles
- plastic and metal bottle tops (especially red)
- foil trays
- bubble wrap
- black plastic food trays/packageing
- milk bottle tops
