The children should be able to talk about how their art was inspired by our focus piece.

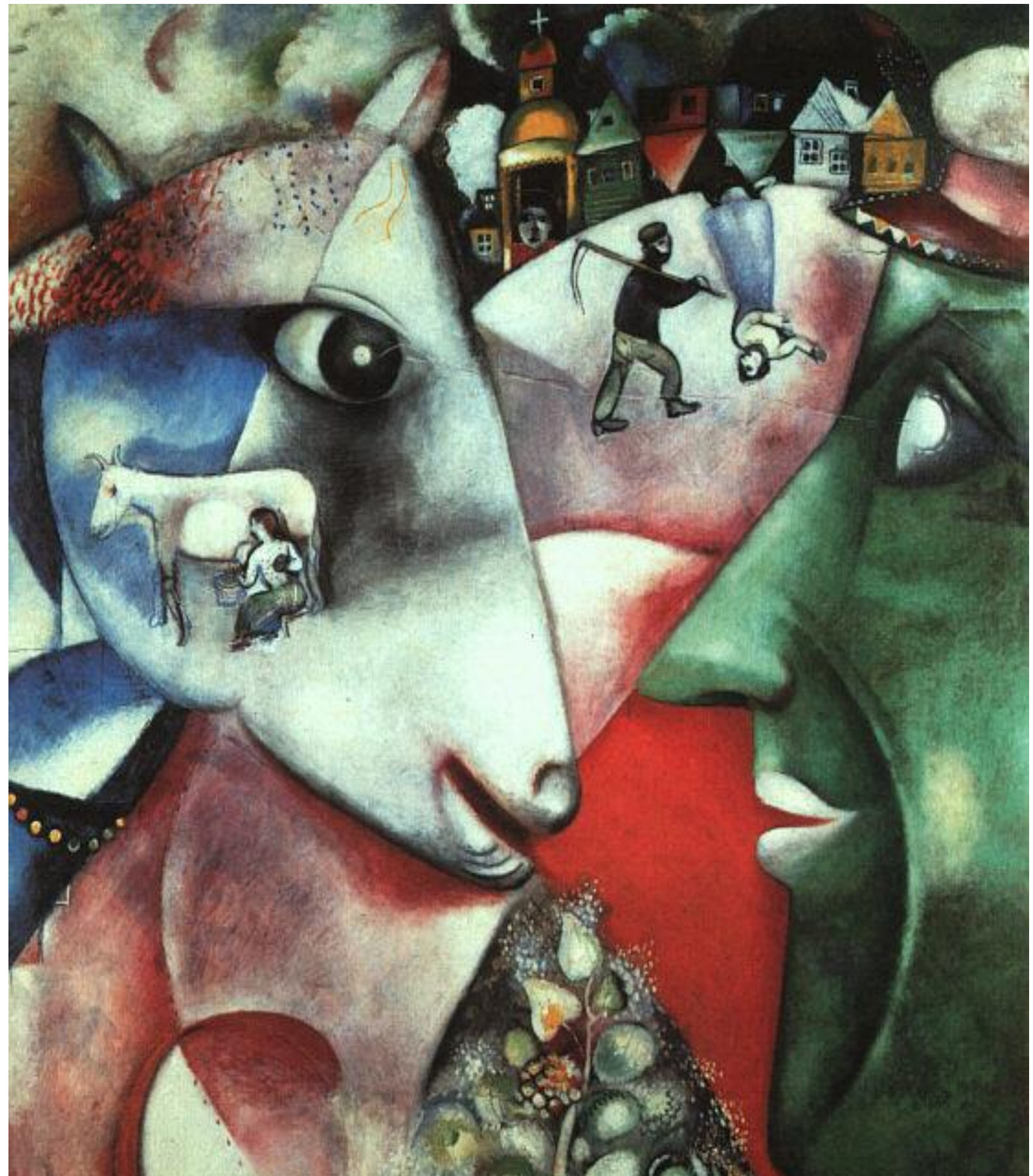
The winning house team will be decided in assembly and will win the special art trophy. Special art stickers will be rewarded to unique entries.
