Reading

- 💡 Use phonic knowledge to decode regular words (e.g. cvc words that can be sounded out – cat, bus, log, slip) & read aloud accurately
- 💡 Read some common irregular words (e.g tricky 'red' words – they, she, said, where)
- 💡 Identify rhymes and alliteration
- 💡 Join in with rhyming patterns
- 💡 Read & understand simple sentences
- 💡 Demonstrate understanding when talking with others about what they have read
- 💡 Make basic predictions
- 💡 Identify start and end of a sentence
- 💡 Enjoy a range of different texts/books



Writing

- 💡 Write simple sentences which can be read by themselves & others
- 💡 Use capital letters and full stops to demarcate sentences
- 💡 Write demarcated sentences with spacing between words
- 💡 Use correct pencil grip
- 💡 Write name (correct upper & lower case), labels and captions
- 💡 Use correct letter formation for familiar words
- 💡 Sit letters upon a line
