# First Aid for Babies & Children

4 hours

This course equips people, especially parents, grandparents, carers and babysitters, to deal with emergency situations and covers the following subjects –

*Primary survey*

*Unconscious casualty*

*CPR on babies (0-1 year old) and children (1 year-puberty)*

*Choking*

*Control of bleeding*

*Treatment for shock*

*Anaphylactic shock*

*Burns & scalds*

*Head injuries*

*Poisoning*

*Meningitis & Septicaemia Febrile*

*convulsions*

*First Aid kit contents*

This is a very practical course where all of the above subjects will be explained, demonstrated to, and practised by all attending the course. With this in mind those taking part will need to dress appropriately, as they will be kneeling on the floor to practise the CPR and recovery position.

All training is in accordance with the Resuscitation Council (UK) Guidelines – this is the body that decides how resuscitation will be done by professionals and lay people in the UK.

A certificate of attendance will be issued on completion of the course which is valid for 3 years.
