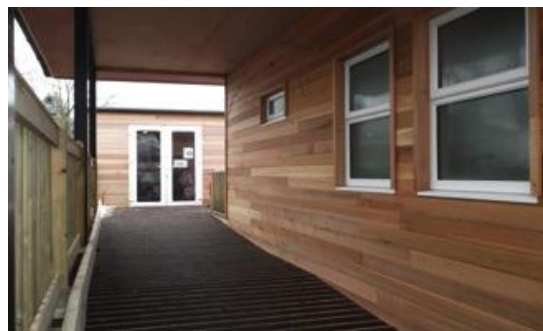


Goldfield Nursery Newsletter
