If you qualify for 'Pupil Premium' Free School Meals then we can easily help with both!

What is Pupil Premium?

Pupil Premium funding is additional funding allocated to all schools to support disadvantaged pupils.

Goldfield receives pupil premium for: children that are cared for or adopted from care; children whose parents are in the armed forces; and for every pupil who has received free (benefit related) school meals over the past 6 years.

This funding is allocated to the school on the basis of the number of children who are eligible for Pupil Premium assistance. It can

only be awarded to pupils only if their parents have applied.



How does the School use the Funds?

- FREE places are available at our after school or lunchtime clubs
- Financial support is provided for trips and in school activities when needed
- Teaching Assistant support ensures Pupil Premium children achieve their full potential
- Additional specialist provision for individuals and small groups, including therapeutic, emotional and well being support
- Provision of resources such as recorders and ocarinas
- Dedicated support from our INCo when needed.

Applying for 'Pupil Premium' Free School Meals?

You can register your child for Pupil Premium if you get any of these benefits:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, provided they are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income (as assessed by HM Revenue & Customs) that does not exceed £16,190

Avoid the confusion...

Since September 2014 all Infant children have been entitled to a free school meal whether benefited related or not. This is called "Universal Infant Free School Meals" (UiFSM).

Pupil Premium Free School Meals are **benefit related** based on your financial position. They come with a free school meal, free milk and the other additional benefits.
