

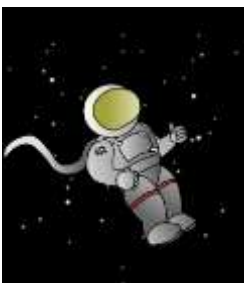
Galactic Goldfield
