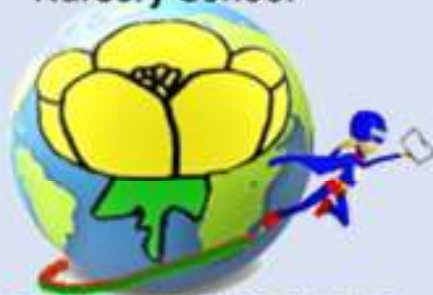


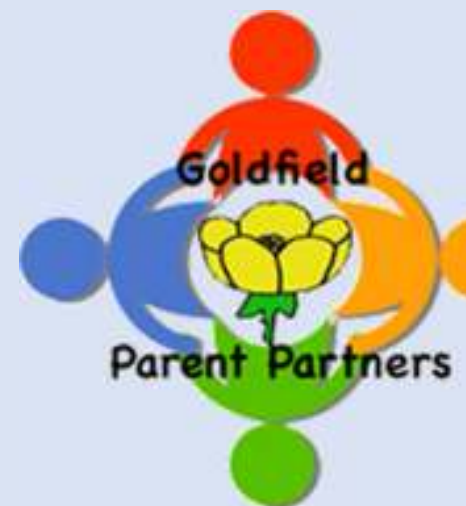

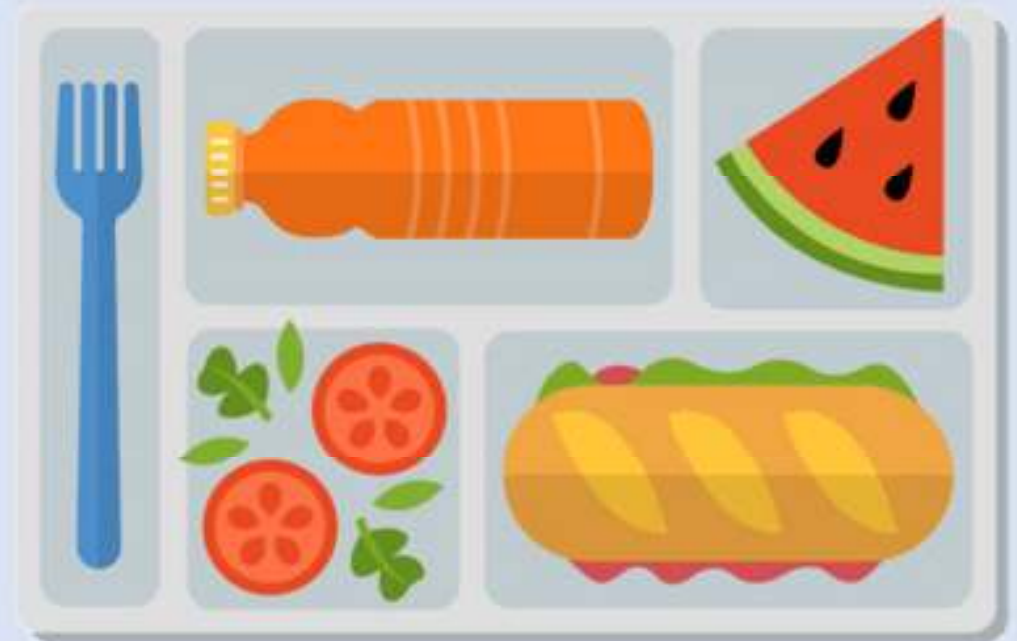

Warm jogging bottoms

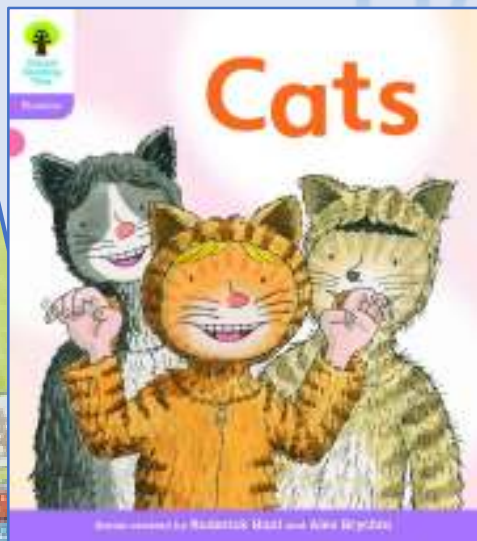
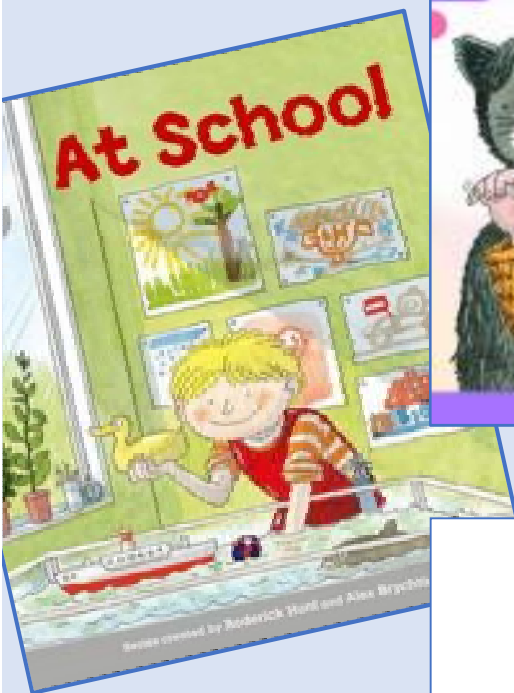

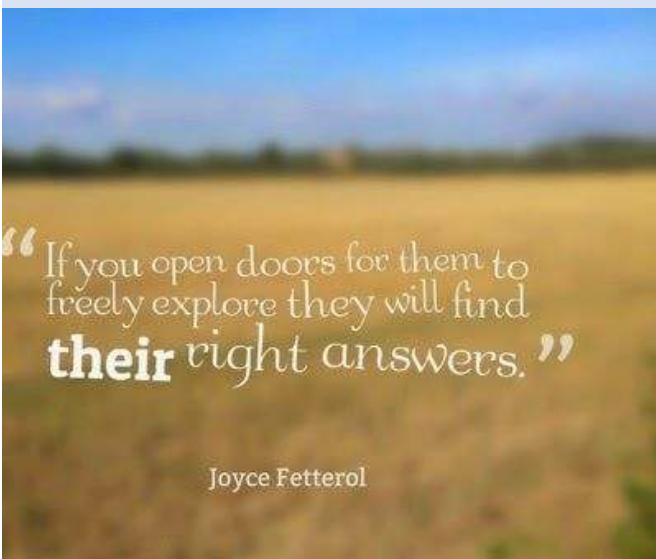
